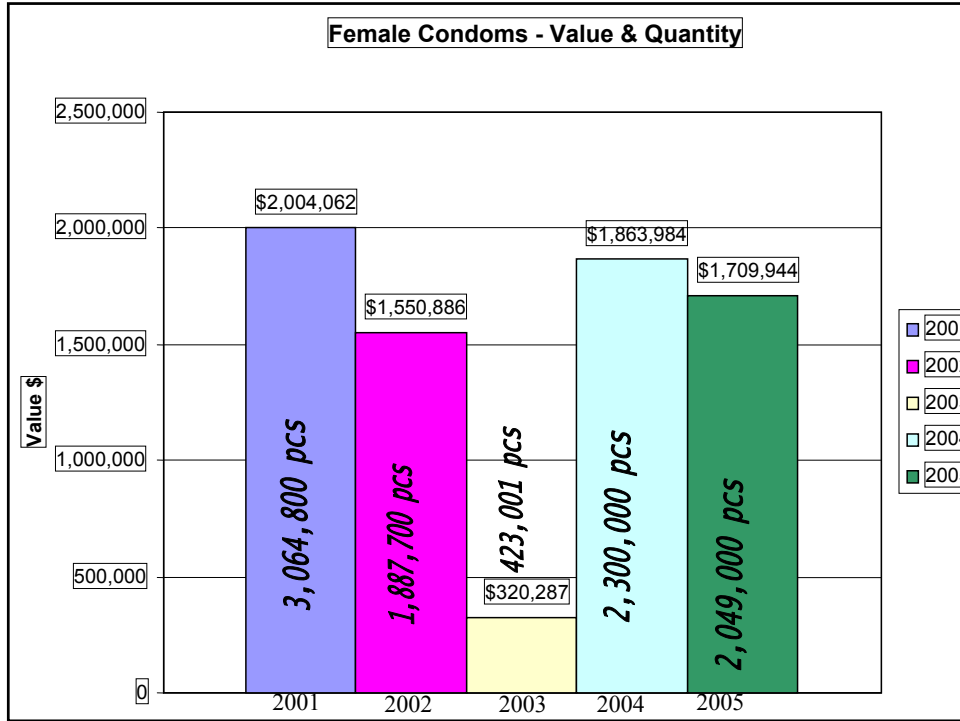

Decision Making Process- New Project Areas



No / limited consumption or demographic data

- Country narratives
 - detailing programming effort
 - plans for introduction of and training on the FC.

Rule-of-thumb – delivery limited to less than 100,000pcs until FC is established

Decision Making Process- Established programmes



- Direct Orders- Gov, UNFPA
- In order to access Trust Funds
 - [1] Central Warehouse inventory data
 - [2] Itemized list of emergency commodities
 - [3] Plans for improving country capacity.

Data is aggregated, allocations are made based on:

most pressing needs-imminent stock-outs; severity of HIV/AIDS; UNFPA priority countries; countries undergoing donor phase-out, countries UNFPA is the sole supplier; countries in humanitarian/emergency situations.

Do we differentiate



- No! The FC is promoted as dual protection
 - Family planning and HIV/AIDS prevention.

- UNFPA's software collects and report the status of public sector RH commodity inventory.
 - gives a snapshot of the state of commodities in specific countries.
 - stock levels, monthly usage rates in the central warehouses
 - Forecasting needs, averting stock outs
 - Assist us in validation of country's requests for commodity purchases
- Implemented to date in 75 countries.
